Dear Applicant,

You have submitted an application to the Erasmus+ Programme – "Jean Monnet Modules, Chairs and Centres of Excellence", 2016 call for proposals for the action specified above. The call for proposals closed on 25/02/2016. The Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) received 737 applications for this action.

I am writing to inform you about the selection decision taken by the Head of Department of the Agency, acting in her capacity as authorising officer, based on the recommendations of an Evaluation Committee assisted by external experts.

I regret to inform you that your application has <u>not</u> been selected for EU co-funding.

It received 83/100 points however given the available budget only applications with a score of 86/100 points and above could be selected for funding.

For your information, out of the 737 applications 147 have been selected for funding for this action. (A further 44 applications have been selected with additional funds allocated to countries outside the European Union identified as priority targets for the EU external action.)

The list of all selected projects will be published on the website of the Executive Agency when all applicants have been notified about the selection results (http://eacea.ec.europa.eu/erasmus-plus/selection-results_en).

Attached to this letter you will find an evaluation report based on the opinion of the external experts. Please take into account that most of the evaluation reports were written by non-native speakers. The Executive Agency will not elaborate further on these assessments.

I thank you for the interest you have shown in the programme and the time and effort you have invested in preparing your application. This decision is in no way a negative reflection on the value and importance of your project.
